• Paintable after one hour of application. However, we recommend using only high quality oil or asphalt based paint. One coat may show a slight discoloration. Two coats will provide a clean film.

For Best Results:

- Caulk in temperatures above 40°F.
- If joint depth exceeds 3/8" x 3/8", use foam backer rod.
- Store caulk away from extreme heat or cold.
